1 Apologies:

Apologies were received and accepted from Councillors Cotton, Berry, Treacher and Mitchell.

2 Member's declaration of Pecuniary Interests:

None.

3 Pavilion Car park

AR explained that David Einig, of David Einig Contracting Ltd, had offered to clear out the flooded area at the exit from the Pavilion parking area, backfill with road planings, and compact. This is at no cost to the Parish Council or Charity.

David Einig Contracting Ltd is contracted to deliver earth to the Greys Green Golf Course in the village, but lorries are prohibited from entering/leaving the golf course between 8:30am and 9:30am. On several occasions the lorries had arrived between these times and waited at the Gallowstree car park. This has damaged an already very poor car park surface.

Mr Einig has now instructed his drivers not to park at the crossroads, and agreed with the Nettlebed and District Commons Conservators, the measures to be undertaken to repair the car park surface at Gallowstree crossroads. Mr Einig also offered to repair the entrance of the car park to the pavilion at the same time, as an act of good will to the village.

Concern was raised that this could compromise the Parish Council's position (the Parish Council being the Sole trustee for the Sports Pavilion and Field Rotherfield Peppard Charity.) Action LC to add to next Parish Council meeting agenda.

It was agreed by a majority vote (one abstain) to accept the offer made by David Einig, of David Einig Contracting Ltd, to clear out the flooded area at the exit from the Pavilion parking area, backfill with road planings, and compact. This is at no cost to the Parish Council or Charity. Action AR to contact Mr Einig.

4 Pavilion Lock

It was unanimously agreed to pay £123 for repairing the lock to the pavilion changing room.
